CORNERSTONE CENTER DEMOGRAPHICS (2017)

- Approximately 150 children served daily; ages 6 weeks to 5 years (kindergarten entry)
- 45% from working families with annual income under \$20,000; 62% under \$30,000; 29% over \$50,000
- 37% pay no tuition per state income guidelines; 17% pay \$1 - \$25 week
- 52% African American; 31% Caucasian; 7% Multi-racial; 6% Hispanic; 1% Asian; 3% Other
- 53% in single-parent households
- 88% from St. Louis city; 10% St. Louis County; 1% St. Charles County; 1% Illinois
- 22% receive developmental therapies on-site and at no additional cost to the families
- 10% in foster care placement
